

Huff and Puff Hexie



Pattern is in US crochet terms

4.0mm hook

Stylecraft Special DK Scheepjes Colour Crafter

They are 3.25" or 8.25cm

In this pattern, I start every round with a standing stitch. You can use chaining instead if you prefer. Every standing stitch or starting chain counts as one stitch in the round.

These make a good size for a temperature blanket.

Begin by chaining 4 and join into a ring.

Round 1

12 dc into the ring. This includes your standing dc or chaining 3. (12 dc)

Round 2

Do one puff stitch in each of the 12 dc from the previous round, 2 ch in between each puff stitch. Puff stitch: complete 5 tr into the same stitch. Remove the hook from the 5th tr, insert it into the 1st tr of the series, pick up the loop that is sticking out from the 5th tr and pull through – cinching the 5 trs together as a puff stitch. So, each puff has 5 tr closed together, and then 2 ch stitches in between each puff stitch. (60trs/12 puff stitches, 24 ch)

Round 3

SI st into the first ch 2 space from the previous round. Do a standing dc (or ch 3), dc, 2ch, 2 dc into the ch 2 space – corner made. Each corner will have 2dc, 2ch, 2dc. Each noncorner or straight section will have 3dc. The sequence is this: 1 corner into the ch 2 space, 1 straight into the next ch 2 space. Continue around in that order – 6 corners and 6 straight sections. Join to beginning standing stitch or ch 3. (42 dc, 12ch)
